CLUB RULES (to be revised shortly)

1. The Club shall be known as Sleaford Wheelers Cycling Club
2. The Club shall be open to either sex, at the Committee's approval
3. Second claim members shall be eligible for Handicap prizes only
4. Relations of riders may join with 'family membership' but will not be able to race
5. The Club Membership will be from 1st February to 31st January
6. Any member joining on or after 1st October will continue membership until the following year. Any person failing to renew their membership by the end of February shall cease to be a member from that date.
7. Club subscriptions for the forthcoming year shall be decided by the AGM or Committee
8. The Club shall promote such road or track events as shall be decided by the AGM or Committee
9. All racing fees for Club events to be paid before the competitor is allowed to start
10. The Club shall be administered by a Committee of various elected officers
11. The Committee shall have the authority to settle any matter not provided for in the rules or to introduce new rules
12. In all Club runs on the open road each member must obey the Law and the Highway Code and in races each member must obey the relevant rules BC or CTT
13. Club runs and tours to be under the supervision of the Club Captain or in his/her absence by the leader who shall be named by the Committee
14. That in the event of the conduct of any member being considered detrimental to the interest of the Club, the Committee shall have the full power to deal with the matter and its decision shall be final.
15. The Committee shall consist of a Chairman, Secretary and three other elected members and the president and vice president and the ex-officio members of the committee
16. The Committee shall consist of members listed in the current handbook
17. In the event of an individual ceasing to be a member of the Club he/she shall be entitled to attend the annual presentation and to receive any trophy due as the result of performances whilst a member of the Club. The trophy shall remain the property of the Club and the former member shall return the said trophy to the designated representative of the Club at or before the conclusion of the presentation event
